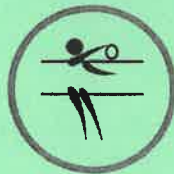



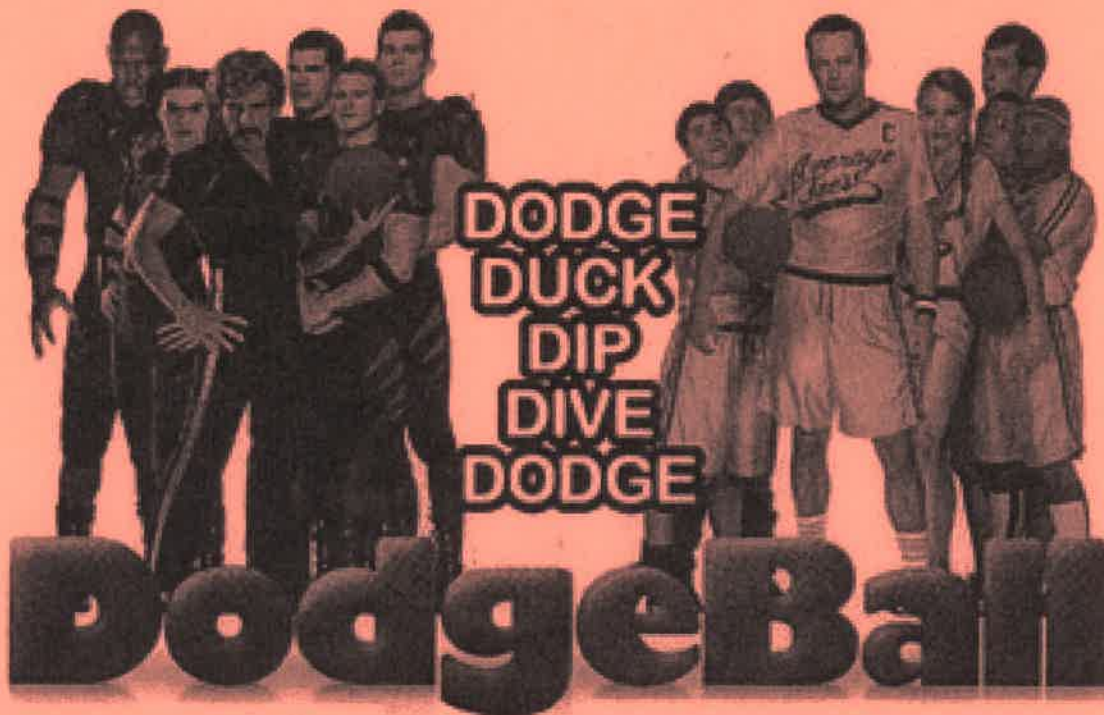

Dear 7th Grade Families:

It's time to start planning for your fundraisers for the Chicago trip! The first big event that you run is the Nativity Garage Sale to be held on June 13-15, 2019. To go on the Chicago trip, the cost per student is around \$950. Through the various fundraisers, families typically earn around \$600-700 and pay around \$200 for their student to attend. Chaperones pay half of the cost.

The Garage Sale is the highest grossing fundraiser for the trip, but also the most work. At this time it is estimated that each family who chooses to participate will be required to contribute at least 20 hours of their time during the setup, sale, and clean up. Please note, an adult must be present with their child during their designated shifts. There will be a number of shifts at various times of the day and on different days of the week, so the hope is there will be shifts that accommodate all schedules. We can discuss this at our kick off meeting.

Please plan to attend our initial planning meeting to coordinate the various fundraisers on February 13 in the Gathering Space at 6:30 p.m. We look forward to seeing you there!

Dear Parents and 8th Grade Students:

Our fundraising is nearly complete! Soon we will be completing your child's 8th grade year and gathering for the final Chicago trip. As we prepare final events and ensure students are ready for the trip. We will meet on **Wednesday, Feb. 13, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. at Nativity** to review fundraising efforts to date, discuss other fundraising opportunities, chaperone needs, and the tentative schedule.

We will need 2 – 3 parent chaperones. Please review the attached chaperone guide and let us know if you are interested by completing the form. The adult chaperones will be supervising groups of 4-5 students during the trip. Boys and girls rooms will be on the same floor, but it is a shape of an "H", and on separate hallways. They are not to go on the opposite side of which their room is assigned. There will also be a security guard on the floor for the overnight and doors are taped shut. **It is the student's responsibility to make sure their chaperone knows where they are at all times. We do have a smaller group this year, so we do not need as many chaperones.**

Planning notes about our trip:

Departure: TUES., MAY 28: *Arrive by 6:15 a.m., we depart the school promptly at 6:30 a.m. (BRING YOUR LUNCH!)*

Medication: *Any medication for your child must be in its original pharmacy container with the student's name on it (prescription or non-prescription). Parents should turn in ALL meds, prescription and non-prescription, before boarding the bus. Students who have emergency medical needs such as inhalers or bee sting kits should carry these with them at all times and inform us that they are carrying them. Becky asks that you complete the health form and inform her of any needs. All over the counter meds also have to be approved and only administered by the chaperone who is managing this during the trip. Tylenol, Tums and Advil will be provided, do not send.*

Packing: ***Clothes & Shoes** - Our students represent Nativity of Mary School, please oversee their packing to ensure that they dress in an appropriate manner when on this trip. Any attire which draws attention to itself, including but not exclusive to, attire which make reference to alcohol, tobacco or drugs, clothing that does not cover the shoulder, midriff, and chest, and short shorts and clothing that does not cover undergarments are unacceptable. If chaperones feel a student is dressed inappropriately, the student will be asked to change into more appropriate attire.*

Students should follow the out-of-uniform school code that is in the school handbook. The weather in Chicago can change very quickly, especially by the lake, so make sure to pack clothes for both warm weather and cooler evening weather. It has been suggested to carry a windbreaker, sweatshirt, or a Gortex jacket with you each day. If you want to check the weather forecast ahead of time, I suggest www.weatheronline.com. Since we will be doing a great deal of walking, they should also **remember to pack**
