


Dear Nativity Families:

HIGHER POWERED LEARNING PROGRAM at NATIVITY

Nativity of Mary School is partnering with the University of Notre Dame in a three year grant through their Higher Powered Learning Program. Their staff is working directly with our teachers, four this year, but all of our teachers over the next three years, to implement a personalized learning program for each child – referred to as Blended Learning.

What does this mean? Our four teachers, Ms. Hartmann, Mrs. Schulz, Miss Thorpe and Mrs. Tronnes, are being trained this year in the implementation of new software, group instruction, and personalized enrichment.

What will this look like for all students this year? In our first year, all staff are studying the "Growth Mindset" and evaluating their classrooms, how they teach, and helping students set individualized goals.
