We celebrate the personal, academic, and spiritual growth of each child and reflect on implementations schoolwide. Here is just a short list of the Strategic Plan goals we met during the 2016-17 school year.

- **Faith Development:** Students growing in acceptance of one another, appreciation of differences and diversity through reflection of Christ. Welcoming of new students to school faith family. Adoration throughout school year. Our Lady of Guadalupe Mass.
- **Responsive Classroom:**
 - Creating a similar focus for all classrooms each day.
 - Developed a loving environment with more self-reflection for students.
