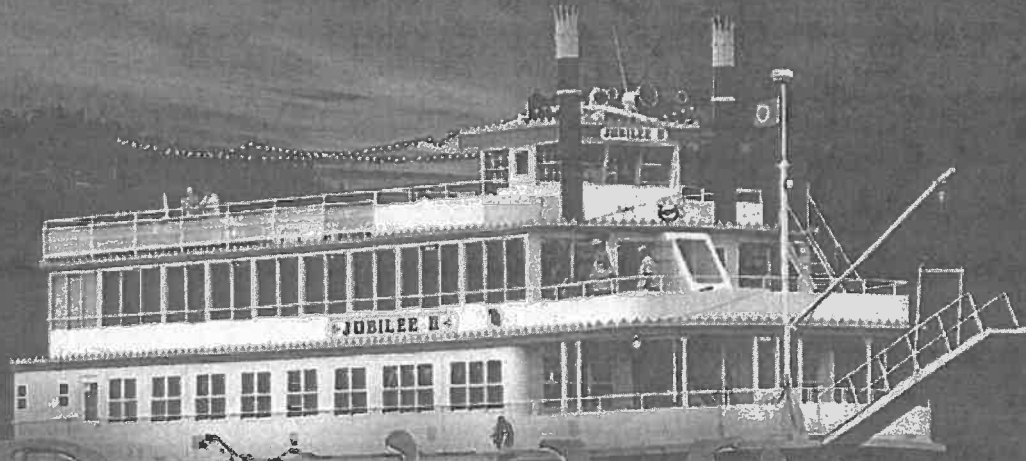

You are invited to be a Nativity Leader! Please consider applying for the Nativity School Safety Patrol for the 2019-20 school year.

What will I do as a Safety Patrol? The responsibilities of this position include:

- *Attend a School Safety training next fall after the start of the 2019-2020 school year.*
- *Patrol the playground one day a week with three other School Safety Patrol Officers under the supervision of school staff and/or parent volunteer.*
- *Resolve minor playground issues and being a good role model/mentor to younger students.*
- *Work with the School Staff/Parent Volunteer to ensure a safe and fun playground experience for all.*
- *Assist the School Staff member/Parent volunteer as directed on the playground.*
- *Make-up any missed homework when class is missed due to Patrol.*
- *Other duties as assigned by teachers or parent volunteers.*

The position of student School Safety Patrol carries responsibility and an obligation of service to the school. Your decision to apply for the position should be well thought out and discussed with your parents. Students in 6th and 7th grade in the 2019-2020 school year will be selected.

Current 5th & 6th Grade Students: If you would like to be considered for the position, write an essay answering the questions below on a separate sheet of paper or email to your homeroom teacher. Please turn in your short response essays to your homeroom teacher prior to **Friday, May 17.**
