PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

 - o 40-50 people attended
 - Survey results show that parents would like more adult events
- Safety
 - Meeting will be held 1/20/17
- Expansion
 - 2 bids are received and being analyzed
 - o Will review with February agenda
 - o Construction will occur over the summer
- Academic Focus Team
 - o Will meet after registration

- Katie (new volunteer director) is helping coordinate
- Attempting to have vendors sponsor part of the service or table
- Need to establish a system
 - Certain grades are responsible for each fundraiser
- Need to engage the parish
- Amazon Smile was discussed; need to promote this fundraising opportunity to the NOM community

School Budget/Tuition for 2017-2018

- Given the changes in the multifamily discount the SAC agreed to eliminate the \$500 new student discount and replace it with a one-time new family \$500 discount
- The school will maintain a \$100 full payment discount if paid by cash or check
- SAC to review the referral program at our next meeting
- Research platforms for online payment options will be presented at the February meeting

Youth Enrichment League

- Based in Carver, MN
- Offers after school program in the Spring
- All Saints has success with this program
- Fee based program with a variety of options
- YEL provides staff and there is no commitment fee or initial investment required
- SAC agreed to try it and agree that offering additional programs at the school is appealing
- Also will inquire with The Works to see they have on-site programs to offer
